Faversham Assistance Centre - FACE Newsletter

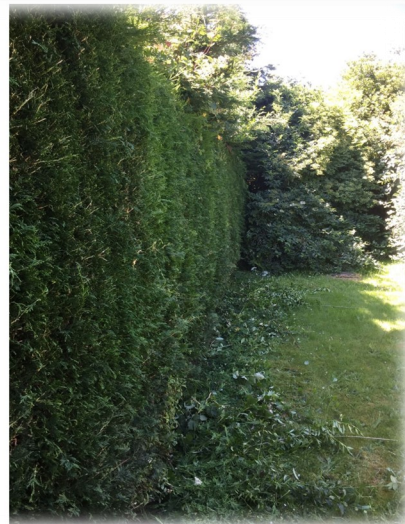
